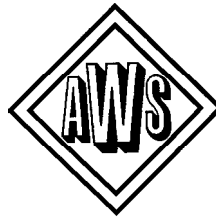

#### Directions to Magill's:

Magill's is located at 7201 Little River Turnpike at its intersection with Backlick Road in the center of Annandale, Virginia. *Just minutes from the Nation's Capital* with convenient access to Interstate 395 (2 miles to the east, use exit 3B), Interstate 495 (2 miles to the west, use exit 52B), Interstate 95 (2 miles to the south) and Interstate 66 (5 miles to the north).

From I-495, Take exit 52-B (236 E/Little River Turnpike). Stay in right hand lane. Drive approximately 2 miles. SUNOCO will be on on your right. After you pass the CVS on your right, turn right into parking lot just beyond CVS. Magill's is the building on the right, Winners on the left.



**Menu:** Cost is \$10.45 (Including Tax) – all you can eat.
